## Hockey Protocols

### WHAT TO EXPECT FOR USERS

- ◆ No more than 25 people will be allowed on the ice for open skate, open hockey and 25+ league
- ◆ No more than 7 people will be allowed in a hockey locker room at a time, locker rooms will be assigned for open hockey and 25+ league, locker rooms will be closed during the day so please come dressed
- ◆ 6 foot social distancing is to be implemented whenever possible including the players box
- ◆ Masks are to be worn while traveling through the facility and when not actively engaged in skating
- ◆ Personal items are not to be left at the facility, items left behind may be disposed of
- ◆ Locker rooms and players benches will be sanitized between user groups
- ◆ Shared equipment will have a new and used area, used equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day or as needed
- ◆ Bleachers, chairs and tables will be sanitized at the end of each day
- ◆ Door handles will be sanitized at the end of each day and at least two additional times during game days
- ◆ Skate rentals will be sanitized at the end of each day when open skate is scheduled, used skate rentals will be placed off to the side in a designated area, HCC staff will place sanitized skates back on the shelf
- ◆ The exterior of the hockey boards will be sanitized at the end of each day
- ◆ All members are to check in at the front desk and all guests are to sign a waiver before entering the arena
- ◆ Children are permitted to use the arena, 17 years old and younger need to be supervised by an adult unless on an active membership, then 16 & 17 year olds may use facility without adult supervision.
- ◆ A registration form and payment is required for the 25+ league

### WHAT TO EXPECT FROM HCC STAFF

- ◆ Hallett Center staff will take a temperature screening before shift and wear a mask while working
- ◆ Staff will check members and guests in for Open Skate, Open Hockey and 25+ League to go over your health screening before you begin
- ◆ NLYHA and Lightning Hockey teams are to abide by their respective screening protocols outlined in their preparedness plans
- ◆ Scorekeepers area will be sanitized between different staff shifts
